A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

16 Classroom primary school at Jobstown/Killinarden, Tallaght.

CONDITIONS

- Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
- That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval shall be observed in the development.
- That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained prior to commencement of development and complied with in full before the structures proposed in the development are put into use.
- That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
- That an adequate and satisfactory landscaping scheme together with the programme for such purposes be submitted to and approved by the County Council. The applicant should consult with the Parks Superintendent with regard to these matters.
- That the access arrangements including internal circulation be fully discussed and agreed with the Roads Engineer.
- That the applicants provide for any necessary wayleave facilities required for the purpose of constructing both foul and surface water outfall systems to Killinarden House.

- To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
