In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2033/78 dated 8th June, 1978. refuse:

for Retention of existing buildings and use as sales yard at Naas Road.

for the following reasons:

1. The retention of this structure and use of the premises without adequate or satisfactory off-street carparking and loading/unloading facilities would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the generation of additional heavy commercial vehicles to and from the site and the obstruction and reduction of site distance caused by heavy vehicles parked on the hard shoulder immediately adjoining the Naas Road dual carriageway National Primary Route.
2. Portion of the lands along the site frontage is seriously affected to a depth of approximately 25' by the Council's road improvement proposals for the widening of the existing Naas Road.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
