DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Covernment (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reasons set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the erection of the said community building in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.

FIRST SCHEDULE

It is considered that the proposed development located in a local centre of commercial and community facilities, can be assimilated satisfactorily into the established land-use pattern so as not to be injurious to the amenities of the area or otherwise contrary to its proper planning and development.

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. The existing row of mature trees along the northern boundary of the site shall be retained save in so far as the removal of any of them
