for the following reasons:

- 1. The site of the proposed development is located in an area indicated in the Development Plan with the objective "To provide for the further development of agriculture." The proposed development is in conflict with this objective and would militate against the preservation of the rural environment.
- 2. The mite adjoins the heavily trafficked Name/Dublin dual carriageway and the traffic movements generated by the proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and reduce the carrying capacity of the dual carriageway.
- 3. An intensification of industrial use on this site which is visible from the dual carriageway would be out of character with the general area and cause a visual distraction to traffic on the National Primary Route.
- 4. The proposals for drainage and water supply are not acceptable to the Sanitary Authority.
- 5. No public piped water or eaverage facilities ere available to serve the proposed devalopment.
- 6. The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deticiency in the provision of water and sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
