Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That before development commences, Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
3. That the structure be removed on or before 1st May, 1983, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
4. That the requirements of the Council's Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly complied with in respect of the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
6. That the applicants satisfy the requirements of the Council's Health Inspector in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1978-1984.
3. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
4. In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
5. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1978-1984.
6. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
