A Chere,

With reference to your planning application received here on 22nd December, 1978, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Clarification is required as to the statement in letter of application that "the route ^{shown} on the enclosed map may be subject to a variation of 40 metres on either side". It is not clear to the Planning Authority why a precise location cannot be determined for these lines.
2. The lodged plans are insufficiently detailed in that they do not clearly show the existing estate or the estate to the west recently granted permission under appeal or the proposed major Council road plan for the area.
A new plan is required clearly showing these features..
