6. That the applicant consult with the Housing Architect, Dublin Corporation, with regard to the provision of a pedestrian access to the site from the residential area to the NorthWest.
7. Details of landscaping and boundary treatment of the site to be submitted for approval by the Council and work thereon completed prior to occupation of school.
8. Offstreet carparking in accordance with the requirements of the Development Plan to be provided within the site.
9. That the area for the replacement school be filled, soiled and seeded.
