2. That the applicant indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.	2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. That the applicant make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.	3. In the interests of amenity and public safety.
4. That the applicant accept responsibility for the repair of the structure at his own expense if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and removal of any services installed in the public street.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.	5. In the interest of public safety and amenity.
6. That the side panels of the proposed shelter be omitted so that the shelter becomes a "cantilever type".	6. In the interests of proper planning and development of the area.
