A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed cattle unit at St. Edmondsbury Farm, LUCAN, Co. Dublin.

CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. In particular, 24-hour water storage to be provided and satisfactory proposal for disposal of surface water and effluent to be agreed with the Sanitary Authority before development commences.
6. That a financial contribution in the sum of £1,000 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In the interest of health.
5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
6. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
