CONDITIONS

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That before development commences, Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, if any, be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
- (4) That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
5. That the road reservation affecting the site is to be set out and checked by the County Council before the commencement of development. That the necessary footpaths and lay-by arrangements be provided along school frontage onto the proposed access roads must be available before the school is operational.
6. That adequate and satisfactory landscaping scheme, together with the programme for such works including the applicant's proposals for boundary treatment such as walls and any necessary fencing be submitted to and approved by the County Council.
