That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure. 4. That the applicants accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and removal of any services installed in the public street. 5. That the lighting of the panels be carried out so as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights. 6.
