CONDITIONS	REASONS FOR CONDITIONS
1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required. 2. That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property. 3. That the applicants make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure. 4. That the applicants accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at their own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and removal of any services installed in the public street. 5. That the lighting of the panels be carried out so as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights. 6. That the proposed shelter is to be so located as to provide free pedestrian passage along the existing footway at all times.	1.
