APPEAL by South of Ireland Public Works and Plant Hire Company Limited of Killeen Road, Inchicore, Dublin, against the decision made on the 17th day of August, 1978, by the Council of the County of Dublin relati to an application for permission for the development of a site at Lugz, Saggart, as a quarry.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the said developme for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The site is a prominent and exposed one in the Dublin Mountain zone in an area designated in the County Development Plan as one of high scenic amenity. It is the policy of the Planning Authority that any development in this area not directly related to its amenity potential or its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming should be prohibited. This policy is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and seriously injurious to the visual emenities of the area.
- 2. The site is in an area served by an extremely substandard road network and additional traffic movements of heavy commercial vehicles which would be generated by the proposed development on this substandard road network would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
