APPEAL by Ashleigh Joinery Limited, of Whitechurch Road, Rathfernham, County Dublin, against the decision made on the 16th day of August, 1978 by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant a permission for the construction of a first-floor extension to an existing joinery works at Whitechurch Road, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts. 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reasons set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the construction of the said extension in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the condition specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said condition being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said condition.

FIRST SCHEDULE

It is considered that the proposed development consists of a reasonable extension to an existing joinery works and that it would not be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area or otherwise contrary to its proper planning and development.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Column 1 - Condition

The developer shell pay a sum of money to the Dublin County Council as a contribution towards the said Council's expenditure on the provision of a public water supply and piped severage facilities in the area. The amount to be paid and the time and method of payment shall he agreed between the developer and the said Council before the development is commenced, or, failing agreement, shall be as determined by An Bord Pleanala.

[Column 2 - Reason for Condition

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
