AND WHEREAS



In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/619/78,** dated **24th February, 1978,** decide to refuse:

~~PLANNING PERMISSION~~ *Outline* **PERMISSION**; ~~PERMISSION~~

for proposed 4 petrol pumps and new forecourt with canopy over Eurohaul Centre,

**Greenhills Road, Tallaght,**

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would contravene materially conditions of existing permissions, i.e. conditions No. 1 of Order No. P/2333/75, dated 31/7/75 (M.738) and condition No. 1 of Order No. P/2926/77, dated 22/8/77 (M.1650).
2. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the large number of traffic turning movements which would be generated by the proposed development onto the Greenhills Road in close proximity to the junction of the Industrial Estate.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
