APPEAL by James Kennedy of Forest Seasons, Kill, County Kildere against the decision made on the 13th day of February, 1978 by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant a permission for alterations to an approved extension to and the change of use of a ballroom to use as a supermarket at Exyfair Ballroom Killians Park, Clondalkin, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reasons set cut in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the said alterations and change of use in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.

#### FIRST SCHOOLE

The proposed development would accord with the use-goning provisions of the development plan, which are considered reasonable. It is not considered that the additional traffic movements generated by the increased floor area involved in the proposal would seriously aggrevate the traffic position in Cloudalkin or that the proposed development would be otherwise contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
