Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.

3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. External finishes of proposed new classrooms to harmonise with those of existing building.
7. Proposed new wall to be suitably copped and finished to match existing walls.
8. Off-street car parking in accordance with the requirements of the Development Plan to be provided.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
3. In the interest of public health.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
5. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
6. In the interest of visual amenity.
7. In the interest of visual amenity.
8. In the interest of proper planning and development of the area.
