A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed temporary system built church at Kingswood, Tallaght, Co. Dublin.

CONDITIONS

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That this permission shall cease to have effect on or before the 31st May, 1980, unless before that date permission for its retention has been granted by the Planning Authority, or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
3. That any necessary advance sign posting and direction signs including any further necessary hedgerow removal or reduction be discussed and agreed with the Roads Engineer.
4. That the main access arrangements to the church site be from a new road network when completed.
5. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, if any, be strictly adhered to in respect of the development.
6. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including a satisfactory disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. To enable the effect of the development on the exercise of powers to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. In the interest of public safety and avoidance of fire risks.
6. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
