AND WHEREAS



In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/107/78** dated **12/1/78** refuse:

The proposed development would contravene materially conditions attached to existing permissions, i.e., Condition No. 16 of Order No: P/915/73 dated 11/4/73 (E. 1755), and would encroach onto approved private open space and would be undesirably close to the proposed Southern Cross Route thereby contravening materially Condition No. 1, of Order No: P/1089/77 dated 6/4/77.
2. The proposed development would be premature as the road layout for the area has not been approved by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanala on appeal.
