

APPEAL by David and Mary Townsend of 18, Sweetmount Avenue, Dundrum, County Dublin against the decision made on the 9th day of January 1978 by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant an outline permission for the erection of a bungalow on a site at Cruagh Road, Rockbrook:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development)
Acts, 1963 and 1976 outline permission is hereby refused for the
erection of the said bungalow for the reasons set out in the
Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The site is in the Dublin Mountain zone in an area designated in the county development plan as one of high scenic amenity. It is the policy of the planning authority that any development in this area not directly related to its amenity potential or its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming should be prohibited. This policy is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and seriously injurious to the visual
- 2. The site is located in an area served by an extremely substandard road network and the generation of additional traffic turning movements by the proposed development on this road network would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
