Dear Sir,

With reference to your planning application received on the 15th November, 1977, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The applicant is requested to submit a site plan to a scale of 1:500 indicating clearly the following:-
 - (a) The boundaries of the site
 - (b) The adjoining dwellings and farm buildings
 - (c) The locations of existing septic tanks adjoining the site
 - (d) The source of proposed water supply.
2. The applicant is requested to submit further proposals regarding water supply and septic tank drainage following discussions with the Health Inspector for the area.

N.B. The septic tank arrangements as presently proposed are not acceptable. The Council's distance requirements regarding septic tanks are as follows:-

- 60' (not more or less) from the house.
- At least 60' from the road boundaries.
- At least 60' from all other boundaries
- At least 150' from any well, spring or similar source of potable water.
- At least 200' from any other septic tank existing or approved.
