Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That before development commences, Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
3. That the position, and details of safety precautions during construction, of the proposed sewer crossing Whitechurch Road be agreed with the Roads Department before development commences.
4. That before development commences, the applicants discuss and agree the permanent drainage arrangements with the Sanitary Services Department.
5. That the applicants agree the proposal, including all necessary wayleaves with the relevant landowners before development commences.
