When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

- 3) Before construction work is undertaken the line of the watermain must be established on the ground by the Waterworks Department and the Developer be held responsible for any subsequent drainage.
- 4) It is important that the Bitumen Sheathing to the pipe is protected from rusting. No machinery should be used to excavate in close proximity to thewatermain. Where excavating must be done adjoining the main it should be done by hand and every care taken not to damage the watermain.

The applicant must agree these requirements with Dublin Corporation Waterworks Department and County Council's Roads Department before re-submitting.
