A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

1. Street bus shelter at Belgard Road, Tallaght.

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in any conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.
3. That the lighting of the panels be so controlled as not to cause excessive glare, distraction to other users, or adjoining property owners, and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting on the adjoining street lights.
4. That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on public property.
5. That the structure be removed and re-located at the applicant's expense in a new position to be agreed with the Roads Department which will be necessary on the completion of the Belgard Road Improvement Scheme and which it is anticipated will be in course of construction during 1978. The applicants must agree the new location with the Roads Engineers.

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. In the interests of pedestrian safety and amenity.
3. In the interests of public safety and amenity.
4. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
