DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said house for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. It is an objective of the planning authority, as expressed in the Dublin County Development Plan, that the area in which the site is located be reserved as an area of high amenity. This objective is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and would militate against the preservation of the high amenity value River Liffey Valley area.
- 2. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because the site is located on a heavily-trafficked national primary road and the additional traffic-turning movements generated by the development would interfere with the safety and free flow of traffic at a point where vehicle speeds are high.
