In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/4096/77 dated 11/11/77 refuse:

for Dwellinghouse at Lucan Road, Palmerstown, Dublin 20.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development which would generate additional traffic turning movements onto a very heavily trafficked National Primary Route would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister of Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to the Local Government in the first instance.
