Long, 104 Orwell Road, Dublin, for the erection of a canopy over a petrol pump island on a site at Drinnagh Road, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the erection of the said canopy in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.
