A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed reclamation of site of shale quarry to agricultural use at Crockaundraenagh,
Rathcoole.

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

2. That the filling materials be of rubble and clay properly consolidated with a finishing layer of top soil not less than 10" in depth, levelled and seeded to the satisfaction of the County Council. Filling materials must not contain domestic refuse, liquid refuse, noxious or organic refuse, scrap metal, any metallic waste materials or objects. Fires, burning of waste materials or noxious fumes are not permitted.

3. The applicant must ensure that the filling operations and filling materials will lead to any contamination or pollution of existing private water supply, water-sources or drainage systems in the area. The applicant must ensure that no unauthorized dumping of any of the unpermitted materials referred to in conditions Nos 2 and 3 takes place.

4. The applicant must ensure that the entrance to the site is properly protected so as to prevent trespassing or illegal dumping by other persons.

5. The applicant must ensure that no debris, mud, slurry, water, litter or other materials are deposited on the adjoining public road by vehicles entering or leaving the site. The proposed access arrangements are to be fully agreed with the Roads Department.
