In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/3613/77 dated 5/10/77 refuse:

for Proposed parking area for buses at 1, Limekiln Lane, Walkinstown.

for the following reasons:

1. The site is situated in an area zoned with the objective to provide for residential development and to preserve and improve residential amenity. The development proposed would contravene materially this objective, would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

2. The proposed development with inadequate access onto Limekiln Lane would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the generation of additional traffic turning movements.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister of Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made at first instance.
