A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed bus shelter at Lucan Road at Filling Station.

Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on public property.
3. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.
4. That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purposes of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.
5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. In the interests of amenity and public safety.
4. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. In the interest of public safety and amenity.
