APPLICANT: *T. Dockrell, Sons & Co. Ltd.,*

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order *P/3376/77* dated *15th September 1977* decide to refuse:

for *Proposed signpost at "The Bungalow", Greenhills Road, Ballymount Road, Upper.*

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would contravene materially the policy statement in paragraph 2.32 of the Development Plan restricting the provision of advertisement structures in residential areas and would accordingly not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.
2. The proposed sign post immediately adjoining the junction of Ballymount, Upper with Greenhills Road would distract motorists at a sub-standard junction on the heavily trafficked main road and would thereby endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
