1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.	2. In the interest of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
3. That the proposed access arrangements, including any temporary constructional access arrangements, be in accordance with the requirements of the Roads Engineer.	3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area and in the interest of public safety.
4. That the necessary access paths to the adjoining Kingswood Heights residential development be located and constructed to the requirements of the Parks Superintendent.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The necessary foul/surface water outfall connections are to be constructed, at the applicant's expense, to the main foul and surface water sewers proposed to serve the adjoining developments. Details of these proposed sewer connections are to be fully discussed and agreed with the Sanitary Services Engineer.	5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
6. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.	6. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
7. That no constructional works on the first stage school buildings are to commence until the proposed new distributor and estate roads immediately adjoining the school and church sites, are completed and in service.	7. In the interest of public safety and avoidance of traffic hazard.
