WHEREAS on the 5th day of October, 1977, the Reverend Mulvey, care of Carroll System Buildings Limited of Bluebell Industrial Estate, Dublin, appealed to An Bord Pleanála against the decision made on the 12th day of September, 1977, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the erection of a temporary church on a site at Kingswood, Tallaght, County Dublin:

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order...P/3295/77.... dated12th September, 1977,..... decide to refuse:

for Proposed temporary system built church at Kingwood, Tallaght;.....

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development on this restricted site with unsatisfactory access and no provision for off street car parking to the existing inadequate public road would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the additional traffic turning movements generated on this existing sub-standard road where vision is restricted.
2. Public piped services are not available to serve the proposal.
3. The proposed development is premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
