for Proposed industrial/warshousing units at Project 301, Units 31/35,...

Wastern Industrial Estate, Fox and Geess, Name Road, Dublin 12.

for the following reasons:

- 1. The proposed development would contravene materially a condition attached to an existing permission, i.e. Condition No 5 of the grant of Gultine Permission by the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Local Government dated 15/1/75. This condition required that no development take place in this area until conditions 1 and 2 had been complied with. The site of this development is in phase II as approved by the Minister.
- 2. The road natwork serving the proposed development is inadequate. The proposal to construct a temporary access road to the site is unacceptable due to is poor alignment and temporary nature and inadequacy of services. Knockmitten Lane at present is too harrow to provide for the proposed development.
- 3. The proposed development is premeture until the conditions imposed by the Minister have been complied with and until the proper road network has been constructed.
- 4. There is no suftable public water supply available until the new 18" main is laid in from the Name Road.
- 5. The proposed development would be premeture by resson of the said existing deficiency in the provision of water supply and the period within which such deficiency may ressonably be expected to be made good.
- 6. The proposed development represents piecemes! development in that it follows field boundaries rather than a regular layout.
