## Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the applicant ascertain and adhere to the requirements of the Building Bye-Laws Engineer.
3. That the structure shall be removed on or before the 30th September, 1980, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Services Engineers.
5. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and adhered to in this development.
6. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained prior to the commencement of development and complied with in full before the structures proposed in the development are put into use.
7. That notwithstanding this permission, the prefab classrooms shall be moved on demand and at the applicant's own expense if the Sanitary Services Department wish to gain access to the foul sewer within the 3 year period.

## Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
