- I. The proposed development is located at an extremely hosvily trafficked junction where off-street car parking is very limited and a considerable amount of haphazard on-streat parking takes In addition buses must stop in the area. off-street carparking facilities for the proposed development are totally inadequate and the subsequent intensification of korb elds parking which would be generated by the proposed development would tend to create serious traffic congestion.
