2. That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.	2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.	3. In the interest of amenity and public safety.
4. That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense if such is necessary, for the purposes of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users of adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.	5. In the interest of public safety and amenity.
6. That the location of the proposed shelter be moved 50-ft eastwards and the shelter to be erected adjacent to the boundary fence in order to avoid interfering with sight lines at the hospital entrance. The exact location of shelter to be the subject of agreement with Roads Engineer on site.	6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
