APPLICANT: Mr. Brendan Grace

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2871/77 dated 16th August, 1977, decide to refuse:

for proposed illuminated sign at, formerly Black Church Inn, Rathcoole,

for the following reasons:

1. The signs, because of their size, location, height and the fact that they would be illuminated at night, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of distraction to road users on this heavily trafficked National Primary Route.
2. The signs, because of their size and location would constitute a major feature which would be out of keeping with the rural character of the area.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
