## Reasons for Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.

2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained, and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.

3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and adhered to in this development.

4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained prior to commencement of development and complied with in full before the structures proposed in the development are put into use.

5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.

6. That the proposed extension be used solely for warehousing purposes.

7. That off-street carparking spaces for the existing and proposed development be provided in accordance with the requirements of the Development Plan.

8. That a financial contribution in the sum of £2,000. (two thousand pounds) be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.

2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services acts, 1878-1964.

3. In the interest of health.

4. In the interest of safety and avoidance of fire hazard.

5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

6. To prevent unauthorized development.

7. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

8. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
