APPEAL by Dan Whelan, of 65, Poddle Park, Dublin, against the decision made on the 15th day of August, 1977, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant an outline permission for the erection of a house on a site at Killakee, Rathfarnham:

<u>DECISION</u>: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, outline permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said house for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The site is located in the Dublin Mountains in an area of high scenic amenity which it is the policy of the planning authority, as expressed in the development plan to conserve. This policy is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and seriously injurious to the visual amenities of the area.
- 2. The site is located in an area served by an extremely substandard road network and the additional traffic movements which would be generated by the proposed development on this road network would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
