In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2449/77 dated 26th July 1977 decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION:~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL.~~

for Proposed advertising structure at gable of 99, Drimnagh Road, Dublin 12.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development is located within an area zoned in the Development Plan to provide for residential development and to preserve and improve residential amenity. The development proposed would contravene materially this objective, would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.
2. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard as a sign of such magnitude would dwarf statutory road signs thereby competing for the attention of motorists.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn (the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
