In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2643/77 dated 28th July, 1977 decide to refuse:

for Proposed revised layout for forecourt facilities and erection of large  
canopy at Jet Filling Station, Drimnagh, Dublin, 12.  
for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development, with unacceptable location of pump island in relation to the proposed road widening line would conflict with the Development Plan objectives for such developments and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.
2. The proposed development would contravene materially a condition attached to an existing permission, i.e., Condition No. 2, of decision to grant permission for a service station on the site by order No: P/41/67, dated 10/4/67. This decision required that the pump island and pumps be set back not less than 15-ft., behind the Drimnagh Road Improvement Line.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
