In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2424/77 dated 18th July, 1977, decide to refuse:

The proposed development would contravene materially condition No.1, of Order Nos: P/548/75, dated 28/2/75, P/4019/75, dated 16/12/75 and P/3742/75, dated 25/11/75, and by reason of the unacceptable separation distance from the proposed New Knocklyon Road Distributor Route would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
