In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2049/77 dated 20/6/77 refuse:

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned to provide for the development of a residential community in the Development Plan. The development proposed on this small residential site, would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity.
2. The proposed development would contravene materially a condition attached to an existing permission, i.e. Condition No. 1. of decision to grant permission for housing development by Order No. P/2626/75 dated 29/9/75.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
