APPLICANT: Allied Irish Banks.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1913/77 dated 9th June 1977. refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for Proposed erection of sign at Allied Irish Banks adjoining to Farm....
Centre, Naas Road, Co. Dublin.

for the following reasons:

1. The erection of a free standing sign at this location would endanger public safety by ~~xxxxxx~~ distracting road users at a point where special vigilance is necessary to avoid accidents.
2. The proposed sign would, because of its prominence and size be injurious to the visual amenities of the area.
3. It is the policy of the County Council to restrict advertising hoardings on the National Primary Routes. If permission were granted for this sign it could lead to a proliferation of similar signs by occupants in the nearby industrial estates.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
