In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1192/77 dated 20th April, 1977 decide to refuse:

for Proposed retention of change of use from barn to workshop at
Coolmine, Saggart, Co. Dublin.

for the following reasons:

- I. The site proposed is located in an area zoned "to provide for the further development of agriculture" in the Development Plan. The commercial development proposed within the curtilage of an existing dwellinghouse would contravene materially this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
