A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.
temporary church at Neillstown, Glendalkin.

Conditions

1. subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the structure shall be removed on or before 31st March 1982 unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or on appeal.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of Sanitary Authority.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. In this regard all effluent from washups to discharge over gully traps.
5. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained prior to commencement of development and complied with in full before the structures proposed in the development are put into use.
6. That off street car parking facilities be provided in accordance with the requirements of County Development Plan. In this regard details of proposed car parking facilities to serve the proposed development to be submitted to and approved by the Planning Authority prior to commencement of development.
7. That a satisfactory scheme of landscaping, planting and boundary treatment be submitted to and approved by Planning

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1871-1964.
4. In the interest of public health.
5. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
