In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/806/77** dated **11/3/77** decide to refuse:

for **2-No. detached dwellinghouses adjoining Orwell Park Estate,**

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area designated as a neighbourhood centre in the Council's approved Action Plan for this area and reserved for Community facilities in conjunction with the adjoining shopping, church and schools complex. The development proposed would contravene materially these objectives, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of property in the area.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
