In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/402/77**, dated **10th February, 1977**, decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for **proposed retention of boundary wall to side of 79, Seskin View Road, Tallaght,**

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would contravene materially a condition attached to an existing permission, i.e. condition No. 7 of Order No. P/1014/68, dated 10/7/68, and would result in a reduction of essential open space for the area.
2. The proposed development would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area and would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
