In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/574/77 dated 22nd February, 1977, decide to refuse:

for Proposed Sanitary Refuse Tiphead at Gleneransan., Brittas.

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned - high amenity open space - in the Development Plan. The proposed development would contravene materially this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
2. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the generation of additional heavy traffic turning movements to and from the site on the adjoining inadequate and narrow public road network.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
